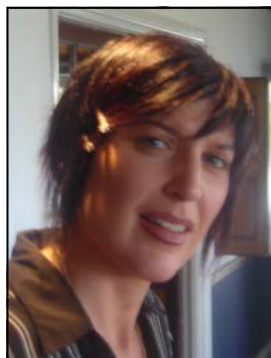


## WELCOME BACK

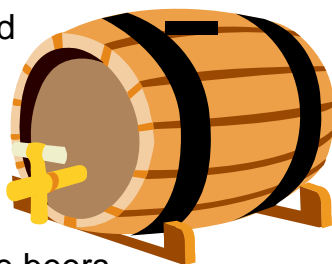

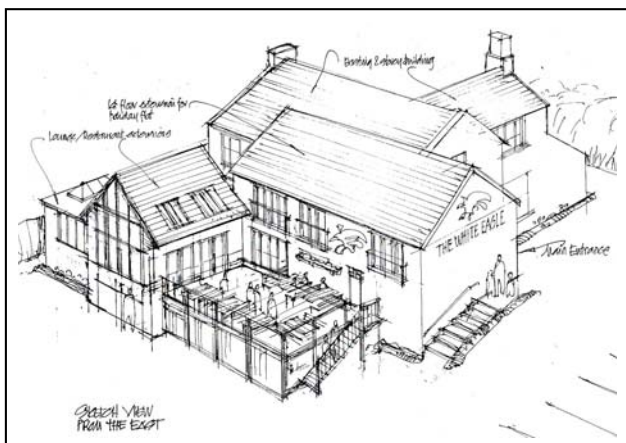
